Born: Leipzig, Germany, Dec 2, 1855;

Son of Theodor Knauth, founder banking firm Knauth, Nachod & Kuhne, and Fanny E. (Steyer) Knauth;

Educated at St. Thomas School, Leipzig; afterwards studied philosophy and law at Universities of Leipzig and Berlin;

Came to U. S., 1877;

Graduated, Columbia Law Sch., A.B., 1877;

Became a citizen of U. S., 1882;

Married, 1st Utrecht, Holland, 1884, Elise Ribbius Peletier (died 1886);

Married, 2nd Chemitz, Germany, Nov. 1893, Else M. Uhlich;

Children: Ilse, b. 1894, Susanne, b. 1895, Ursula, b. 1899, Berthold, b. 1905, Johannes Peter, b. 1907.

Served clerkship under ex-Gov. Salomon in N. Y. City;

Formed firm of Briessen, Steele and Knauth, with Arthur v. Briessen and Sanford H. Steele in 1884; continued since 1889 under firm name of Briesen & Knauth, engaged in general practice.

Member Citizen's Union for many years;

Has taken part in every movement for reform of City Gov't.;
